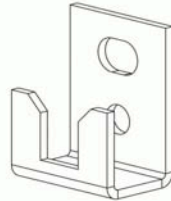

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION



STAND-OFF

- Identified by round neck
- used for symmetrical art
- used anytime the plane of the glass requires more than one stand-off to equally float off the wall



STANDARD BRACKET

- Large oval hole for minor adjustments
- Sm. round hole (optional) for stabilizing when using Locking stand-off
- 25 lbs. per bracket



LOCKING STAND-OFF

- Identified by square neck
- Locks into bracket
- For uneven dist. of weight, pieces less than 15" x 15"
- Individual use only

DIRECTIONS FOR HANGING:

Locking stand-off and bracket:

1. If you do not find a stud, use an anchor.
2. Screw bracket into the wall
3. Slip the stand-off 's groove into the bracket.
4. To angle when using one locking stand-off simply rotate the bracket and use the second small round hole to hold the angle.

Multiple Stand-offs (round-regular):

1. If you do not find a stud, use an anchor.
2. Screw highest #1 bracket into the wall and place corresponding #1 stand-off into the bracket on the wall.
3. Couple the next #2 bracket with the #2 stand-off. Then rotate #1 stand-off in #1 bracket until you find your desired angle or piece is level.
4. Trace the corner of #2 bracket.
5. Use traced corner as a guide when screwing in the #2 bracket.
6. Look to the side and watch to make sure you place the groove in the stand-off into the bracket. Stand-offs should easily slip into the channels of the brackets. Large oval hole in bracket allows for minor adjustments when hanging more than one stand-off on a piece.
7. Repeat steps for additional stand-offs. No more than 4 stand-offs should be placed on a panel of glass, instead increase your diameter.
