CODE	STYLE NAME	DESCRIPTION	APPX. LBS IN STOCK
001001	Antique White	Light cream opalescent. Highly reactive to copper, lead and silver.	60
001001	Apricot Tint	Palest orange-yellow. Very transparent.	20
002002	Blue-Green Algae 2	A new blend of an old favorite. Blue and green aventurine glasses, streaked with varying amounts of clear and white. This darker, transparent version of the original has great variation in the run.	20
001321	Carnelian	Deepest transparent brown-red, the same formula as Carnelian (001321) sheet glass.	60
001138	Dark Amber	Darker version of Medium Amber (001137).	40
001001	Deep Aubergine	Deepest brown-purple opalescent, like the skin of a dark eggplant.	90
002002	Deep Blue Algae	This mixture of Dark Aventurine Blue in a clear and transparent teal base results in a bloom of inky, watery streaks, laced with tiny sparkles. Expect variation.	20
000224	Deep Red	This style deepens with heatwork, resulting in a dark crimson. Opalescent. See the sheet glass version on page 9 of Bullseye Catalog 5.	160
002002	NEW Forest Mist	Versatile blend of medium opalescent greens, clear and Translucent White (000243). Forest Mist takes on a foggy, marbled look if Translucent White is struck from its original clear state. Once a bead is formed, allow the material to cool considerably, then gently reheat and cool to strike. Expect variation. 001001	Fudgesicle	Dark translucent brown.	70
002002	NEW Glacier	An icy, streaky blend of Aqua Blue Tint (001808) and white. Expect variation.	50 First day limit--2 pounds
000304	Lavender	A muted blue-lavender opalescent. This color is reminiscent of classic, powdery-purple-pastel wafer candies. Similar in color to previously released Gonzo Grape.	30
001001	Lavender Blush Tint	Palest transparent lavender with a hint of pink. Very similar in color and nature to Neo-Lavender Tint (1842), including color shift properties. Depending on the light source, Lavender Blush Tint will appear palest pink-lavender or lightest blue-lavender.	50
001002	Light Pink Sapphirine	Lighter shade of pink than Light Pink Striker (001215), with a brownish surface color.	100
001416	Light Turquoise Blue	Transparent, less saturated version of Turquoise Blue (001116).	70
000138	Marzipan	Pale almond opalescent. A slightly translucent, nonreactive neutral.	110
001001	Opaque Mint Green	Mint green with greater opacity than standard 000112 opalescent. Maintains color and opacity, even in small amounts.	10
001001	Opaque Turquoise	Medium turquoise with greater opacity than standard 000116 opalescent. Maintains color and opacity, even in small amounts. Upon heating, a mark or texture may develop on the surface of the rod, but with continued heating, it will dissipate.	10

CODE	STYLE NAME	DESCRIPTION	APPX. LBS IN STOCK
001001	Orange Lollipop	Transparent orange striker with an opalescent orange streak. Saturated with color, once completely struck.	70
001001	Pale Plum	Less saturated version of Light Plum (001405).	80
001001	Periwinkle	Pastel blue violet, opalescent.	130
000225	Pimento Red	This tasty shade of opalescent orange is a shade darker than our standard Orange (000125). See the sheet glass version on page 8 of Bullseye Catalog 4, but note that the struck rod color is a little lighter.	170
001002	Purplicious	Medium purple (more pink than blue). Think sweet grape-flavored bubble gum. Some color variation in the run. May mottle when worked hot. Opalescent.	10
001001	Robin's-Egg Blue	Natural, true, robin's-egg blue. Muted, turquoise opalescent. This color is <i>exactly</i> the reason we reserved the name, instead of using it for what is now referred to as Light Cyan (000216).	10
001001	Sterling Gray	This pastel, opalescent gray is a lighter version of Deco Gray (000136).	70
000310	NEW Umber	Opalescent brown named in the tradition of the naturally occurring pigment. This run tends to be redder than our sheet glass version. A shade browner in relation to Cinnabar (000309-76).	160
001001	Wisteria	Medium transparent blue.	94
