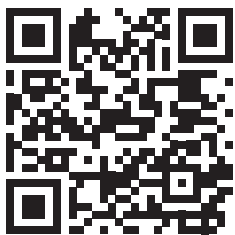


Make a snowy, sparkly, pastel snowflake or two. No appointment needed. Simply follow the steps below and learn to create this wonderful glass project. The prepared mold, glass, and kiln firings are all included.

1. Choose your mold
  - a. Single Large, \$25
  - b. Double Small, \$30
  - c. Double Medium, \$40
2. Choose your glass colors
  - a. Use a solid color
  - b. Create a gradation
  - c. Mix and match your own design
3. Watch the short video to see an overview of the process
4. Use the scale & condiment cups to weigh your glass
  - a. Single Large, 42–48 grams
  - b. Double Small, 9–11 grams per snowflake
  - c. Double Medium, 29–30 grams per snowflake
5. Fill your mold. Be careful not to scratch or scrape the prepared mold surface
6. Use a brush to lightly sweep in stray pieces of glass. Tap to settle the glass into the mold
7. Fill out a Snowflake Form and take it to the register

<b>4</b>	AFAP*	70°F / 21°C	0:00
